Assignment

Part 1

Write an XHTML document that collects the total bill, number of people, and tip percentage from a client and invokes a JSP document that computes each person's contribution. The XHTML document must include radio buttons for indicating the currency of the bill: (at least) `Dollars(USD)`, `Yuan(CNY)`, `Pounds(GBP)`, and `Euro(EUR)`. This selection must be extracted using JSTL and included in the response.

Part 2

Write a single JSP document that does the above.

What to hand in

- (1) A 2-up copy of your web pages including examples of any dynamically generated documents.
- (2) A test plan (input, expected output, rational).
- (3) Email me a tar ball named `<your-account-name>.tar.gz` that includes your source and annotated screen shots showing off how the execution of your test plan. You may do this for either Part 1 or Part 2 (they do produce the same output right?).

Notes

- (1) For the last time! you get to work alone :(
- (2) The JSP document must use JSTL.
- (3) You will need to use `tomcat` for this assignment.
